In November 2016, we outgrew the Pasadena, CA facility where we'd been since 2000 and moved in to an all-new facility in San Dimas, CA.

For our 25th anniversary, we present the strongest line of frames we've ever developed, refining our time-tested single pivot designs to the highest level.



You can't beat an aluminum alloy frame in an off-road environment for dependability and durability. We have been specializing in building with this material for 25 years. We believe that carbon fiber and carbon composite has its place, but not in the harsh conditions of mountain bike riding and racing.

Carbon frames are easier to build than aluminum alloy frames and give companies a higher profit margin. That is why so many bike companies chose this direction. There is no soul in a plastic bike!

Working with metal is an art, requiring skilled labor and time, and every frame we build reflects this.



Our bikes are built to last many seasons, not 1-2 seasons, or need replacing the first time you drop it on a rock. Metal mountain bike frames can survive the daily abuse of small dings and dents, as well as general surface wear and tear. Metal frames can be realigned, repaired, or refinished with virtually no compromises.
